



ERECTED BY THE  
ROCKLAND COUNTY SOCIETY  
TO COMMEMORATE THE OPENING OF THE  
NYACK TURNPIKE

BETWEEN NYACK AND SUFFERN  
THE FIRST DIRECT HIGHWAY ACROSS THE COUNTY OF ROCKLAND  
AND THE FIRST IMPORTANT PUBLIC WORK UNDERTAKEN THEREIN  
BY PRIVATE ENTERPRISE.

THE NYACK TURNPIKE ROAD COMPANY WAS INCORPORATED BY  
ACT OF THE NEW YORK LEGISLATURE APRIL 17TH, 1818. WHEN A  
NEW CHARTER WAS GRANTED, APRIL 20TH, 1830. THE FOLLOWING  
MEN—THE PROJECTORS AND FOUNDERS OF THE NYACK TURNPIKE—  
WERE APPOINTED TRUSTEES:


JAMES SMITH JOHN GREEN PETER SMITH LUCAS ACKER  
EDWARD SUFFERN ISAAC LYDACKER JEREMIAH H. PIERSON  
UNDER THIS CHARTER—RENEWED IN 1853, 1873 AND 1883—THE  
TURNPIKE WAS MAINTAINED AS A TOLL ROAD UNTIL 1893. IT  
BECAME A PART OF THE COUNTY ROAD SYSTEM IN 1894 AND WAS  
DESIGNATED AS A STATE HIGHWAY IN 1911.

AT THIS PLACE, THE MODERN THOROUGHFARE FOLLOWS THE  
COURSE OF AN INDIAN PATH OF PREHISTORIC DAYS.










