RESOLUTION OF THE NYACK VILLAGE BOARD APPROVING THE REMOVAL OF SIDEWALK AT 18 FRONT STREET

WHEREAS, the Nyack Village Board has the legal authority to allow construction or removal of sidewalks within the Village Right of Way;

WHEREAS, the sidewalk at 18 Front Street is in unsafe condition and cannot be repaired without removing a large healthy street tree;

WHEREAS, architecture and arborist professionals have evaluated the situation and considered options such as building a raised walkway over the root system and detouring the sidewalk into the parking lane, finding these options inadvisable for various reasons;

WHEREAS, the sidewalk at 18 Front St meets reasonable criteria for removal, including its location in a non-commercial area, its duplication with another sidewalk on the opposite side of the street, its adjacency to a high-value tree, its being damaged beyond repair, its presenting an immediate and urgent safety hazard for pedestrians, and finally, the adjacent property owners support the removal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE NYACK VILLAGE BOARD AS FOLLOWS:

RESOLVED that the Village Board is desirous of both preserving trees and insuring safe pedestrian passage,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Village Administrator is directed to take action to facilitate the removal of the sidewalk at 18 Front Street, and take such other measures as appropriate to insure safe pedestrian passage and tree survival.
